Usage

```
webuse(data, version = 15, envir = parent.frame())
```

```
webuselist
```

Arguments

<code>data</code>	A character string containing the name of a Stata dataset.
<code>version</code>	An integer indicating the version of Stata for which to retrieve the named dataset. Default is version 14 (current as of June, 2015).
<code>envir</code>	An environment in which to store the object. By default, this will be the parent environment (often the global environment).

Details

`webuse` retrieves a named Stata dataset from Stata’s server and loads it as a named object in the specified environment.

`webuselist` provides a named list of (some of) the datasets available. Use `names(webuselist)` to retrieve the datasets.

Value

A `data.frame`, invisibly.
